Purpose

Scope of Responsibilities

For ACER Workgroup to assist ACER Oversight in carrying out its mission and maintaining its objectivity and independence, ACER Workgroup's purview includes:

- Current project-specific summaries of significant reports issued and their observations
- Identification and assessment of emerging risks for consideration in future audit plans
- Proposal and identification of new and ongoing risk mitigation measures
- Open recommendations and/or management corrective actions from previously issued audit reports, especially for situations where senior management awareness could lead to more rapid action or the removal of barriers to action to improve controls
- Regularly review campus training compliance statistics and propose enhancements to improve compliance
